



Let's Sing!

Psalm 96: 1-9

Gather: Sit in a circle with your family, and join hands while you say the opening prayer.
“Dear God, we are so thankful for this wonderful day. Thank you for our family, friends, and many blessings. Please watch over us, and be with those who are not with us that they may feel your love. Amen.”

Lesson: Do you like to sing? God gave us a wonderful gift...our voice!! We use our voice to create amazing sound, and when we sing with words, it's called a song. We sing songs often to tell a story, express how we feel, or even to praise God!

Psalm 96 says, “O sing to the Lord a new song; sing to the Lord, all the earth.
